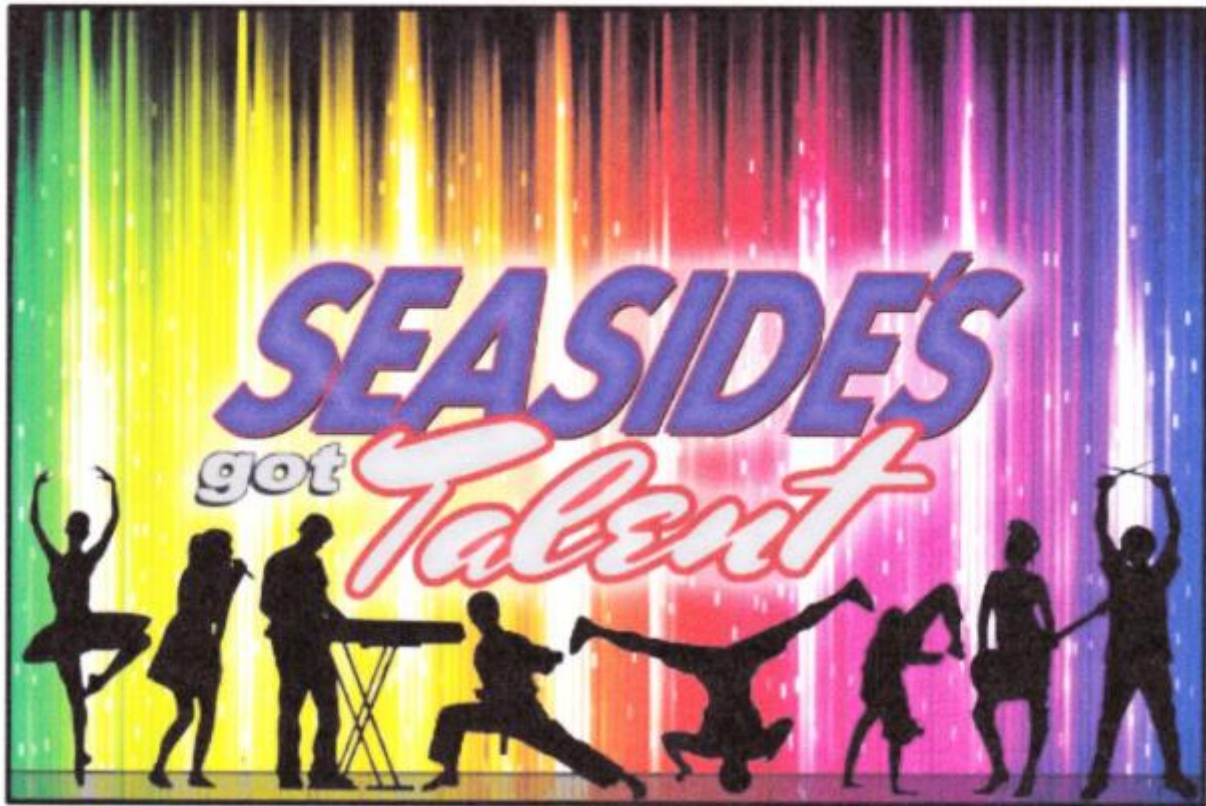

This year's Variety Show will take place at West High School Pavilion on **Friday, April 28, 2017**. Students can sing, dance, play an instrument, recite poetry, perform a skit, demonstrate athletic ability such as gymnastics or martial arts, perform music or dance of another culture, or demonstrate any other special talent they may have. There will also be an optional finale number for students who are able to attend after school rehearsals. This is a great opportunity for students to shine!!

The following rules and guidelines have been established in order to ensure fairness to all students and ease in producing the show. Please read them carefully before submitting an entry form, and please mark highlighted dates on your calendar:

- The attached form must be filled out with the names of **all participants**, one parent contact, e-mail, phone number, and name and type of piece to be performed. **Please write your email address neatly** - this is how we will get in touch with you.
- All acts must be age appropriate, including costumes, lyrics and themes.
- Acts can be no longer than 2 minutes.
- If singing, **no lip syncing or singing along with recorded vocals**. Please use karaoke cd's, live music, or recorded instrumental music for accompaniment.
- Students must rehearse with parental supervision outside of school.
- Students may not appear in more than one number (with the exception of the finale).
- Due to time constraints, the number of acts may be limited. Entry forms will be considered and accepted in the order in which they are received... **so please submit your entry form as soon as possible**.
- Please be original and creative - duplicate acts will not be allowed.
- All participating students must be prepared to audition their act in front of the Director after school in the Seaside Cafeteria.
- Each act must have all of its own live or recorded music prepared (CD or mp3 tracks). A piano will be provided, and the DJ will play CDs or mp3s. If your child's performance requires music please turn in a CD with your child's name on it by **Friday April 14th**. CD will not be returned.
- The Variety Show committee will have final decision over every aspect of the show.

TIMELINE:

- **Friday, March 3rd**: All entry forms must be received in the office folder marked "Variety Show" by end of day.
- Beginning on **Wednesday, March 1, Finale rehearsals** will take place in the Seaside Cafeteria on **Wednesdays from 2:30-3:30pm**. All performers may participate in the Finale if they attend the rehearsals.
- **March 6-10**: Auditions. You will receive an email giving you your date and time. Please be prepared with acts and music.
- **Tuesday, April 25 at 6pm sharp: Mandatory dress rehearsal** at West High Pavilion.
- **Friday, April 28th (starts at 6:30pm): Variety Show** at West High Pavilion.
