Did you know that the school's yearly student achievement budget is only \$11,489? That is less than \$21 for each of our 559 students. Without **YOU** our students would miss out on all the programs that **YOUR** contributions help pay for.

Where does the money go?

- Adventures in Art: \$4,200
- Assemblies: \$6,500
- Field Trips: \$6,000
- Library: \$1,500
- Teacher Supplies: \$8,000
- Staff CPR Training: \$2,000
- Noon Aides: \$4,000
- Playground Equipment: \$3,000
- Family Nights: \$5,000 (Movie night, Ice Cream Social and more!)
- Gift to school: Chromebooks for the lower grades (3 per classroom): \$12,700
- Walk Through CA and Revolution: \$2,900 (4th and 5th grade interactive history programs)
- Super Sunday (Campus Beautification): \$2,000
- Computer Teacher: \$28,000 (currently looking to hire new teacher)
- Computer Lab/ Tech Support: \$1,000
- P.E. Equipment: \$1,300



Grand total of above programs is \$88,100.
