Greetings, Seaside Dolphins!



I am pleased to announce that summer school information is being distributed. There are a few options for summer school this year.

1. **The South Bay Enrichment Academy** (SBEA) offers summer programs taught by many of our TUSD teachers for a reasonable fee. The program runs from July 3 - July 28,  
8 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. 
2. **Jump Start**: This is a no fee **intervention** summer school provided to students who meet the **qualification criteria**. If your child qualifies, you will receive an invitation letter. A 'yes' or 'no' response (RSVP) is requested. The program runs from July 31 - Aug. 18, 8 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. 
3. **Newcomer Program**: This is a program for children who are new to the U.S. and learning English. If your child qualifies for this program, you will receive an invitation letter. The program runs from July 31 - Aug. 18, 8 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

4. **Extended School Year and LACOE:** Some students with special learning needs will be eligible for summer support. Each individual is unique and needs are determined on a case by case basis. The learning specialist will contact you, if applicable.



**Dismissal:** Reminder - school is out at 3:12 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday and at 2:27 on Wednesday. Please, **do not wait** for your child **on campus**. We need to keep the campus free and clear so that we can see and hear students. A free and clear campus creates a safe and orderly environment and allows children to focus on learning until the end of the school day. Thank you for your support. When we work together, our children benefit most.

April 7<sup>th</sup>! Our annual event is fast approaching. On this day, each grade span runs as many laps as they can in support of our school. Adults are welcome to run for fun too! 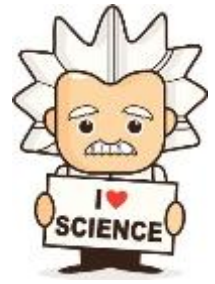

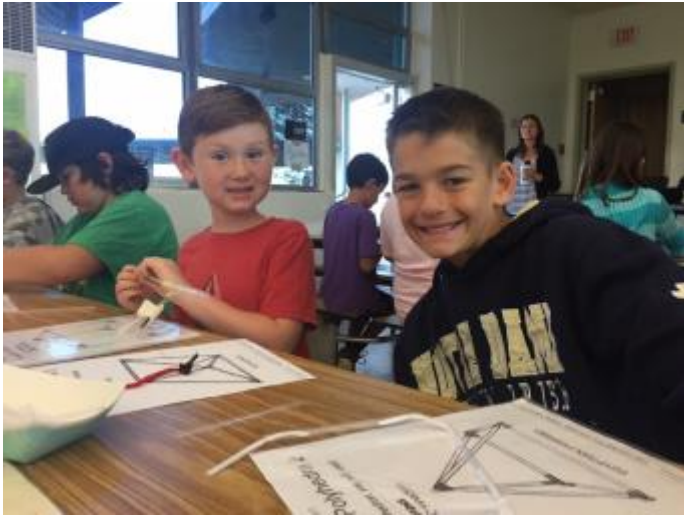
## Another Fun Assembly: Unique Game Show

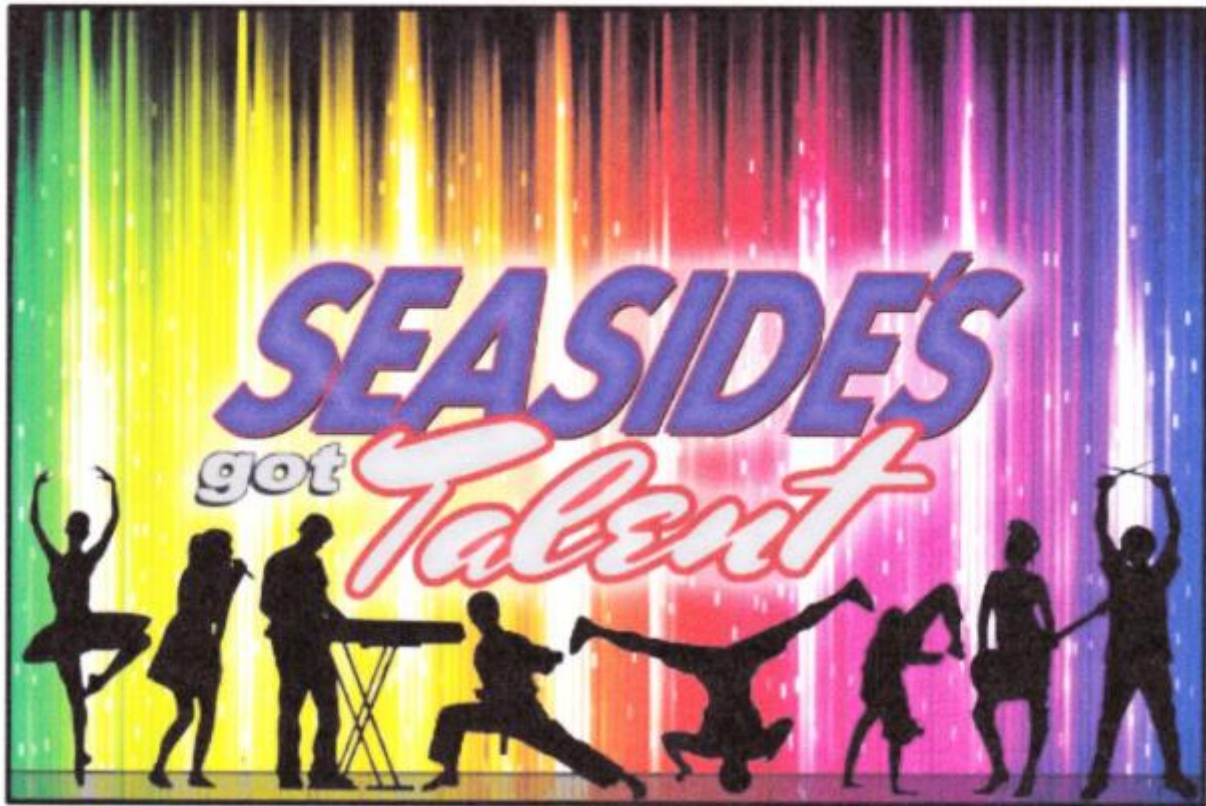
